

BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

1. The bidding committee must be made up of at least three members of AA. Experience suggests that these people should have more than one year of sobriety.
2. Bidders must have commitments from at least two hotels including dates showing availability of banquet and speaking rooms in the hotels, and proof that the hotels require no commitment as to the number of people attending.
3. Assurance must be given that no other AA conference or large function will be held in their city within a 30-day period before or after the proposed conference date.
4. Statements of support from the AA area chairperson and the intergroup secretary or central office must be brought to the bidding conference.
5. Bidders will be required to demonstrate financial autonomy within the 12 traditions of AA.
6. If awarded the conference, bidders must agree that all proceeds, after expenses, will be turned over to the WICYPAA Advisory Council for their disposition within 60 days at the end of the conference.
7. Bid cities must present their bid to the Advisory Council at the conference.
8. Bidders are asked to prepare a statement of what they think the benefits of hosting a WICYPAA conference in their area would be.
